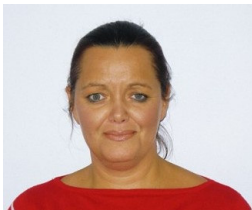
KRISTIN MACLEOD RGN RM, OCCUPATIONAL HEALTH NURSE

I enjoy entertaining friends with big parties and travelling as much as possible. My family are very important to me and my downfall is sweets.

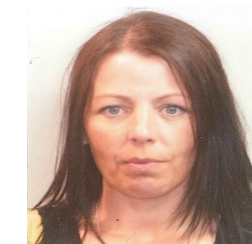
HELEN RUDDY RGN, OCCUPATIONAL HEALTH NURSE
